7/1/2016-6/30/2017 Audit Presentation

Discussion:

Matt Brickey, CPA and Manager of McBride, Lock & Associates, LLC presented the results of the 7/1/2016-6/30/2017 Single Audit. Also known as the OMB A-133 audit, is an organization-wide audit or examination of an entity that expends \$750,000 or more of Federal assistance (commonly known as Federal funds, Federal grants, or Federal awards) received for its operations. Mr. Brickey reviewed each page of the audit document and provided responses to the board members questions. Mr. Brickey explained in detail how the HOME units are recorded as an agency liability and that it is not likely to have to be paid out. Removing this amount indicates that the agency is in really good financial shape. No findings were identified in the Single Audit. Mr. Brickey also reviewed the 990 with the board members and board members were given the opportunity to review and discuss the document.
